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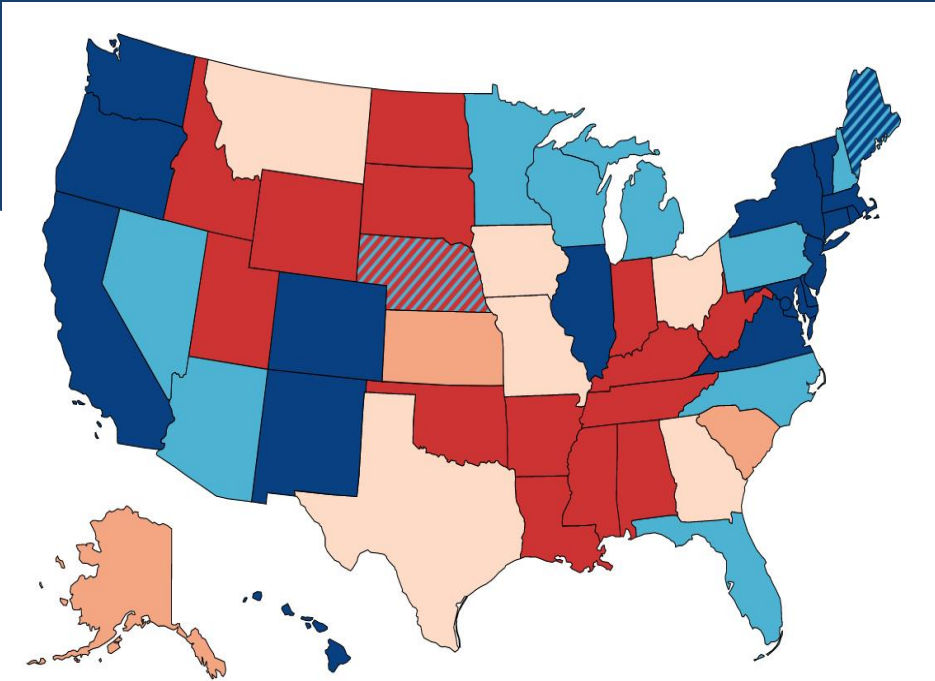

*Our Prediction: (D) Biden wins with 335 EV*

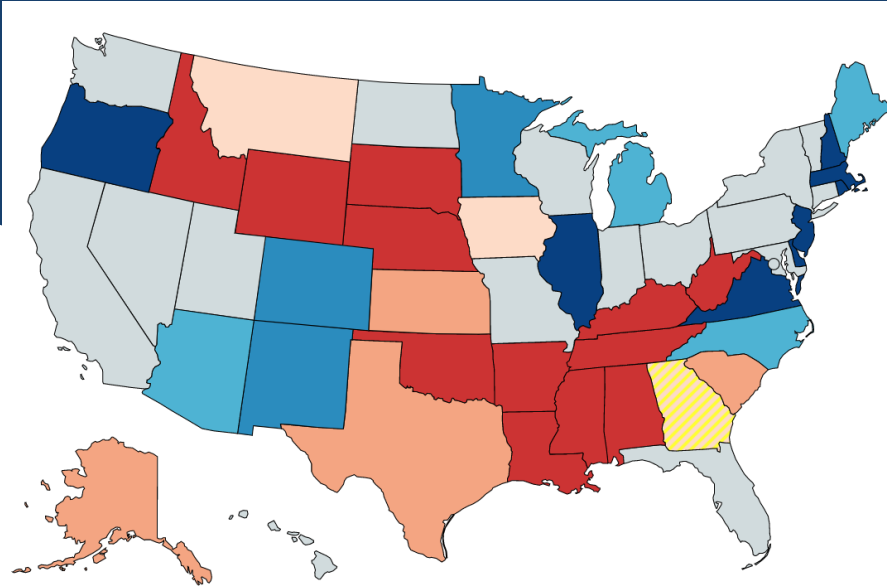
